Tony Elumelu Invest \$100 Million On African Entrepreneurs

USPA NEWS - On July 10 2015, The Tony Elumelu Foundation Host 1000 Pan-African Emerging Entrepreneurs In Lagos, Nigeria To \$100M Tony Elumelu Entrepreneurship Programme Boot Camp. (Rebuilding Africa) "I am confident that these entrepreneurs are Africa's hope for the future," Mr. Tony Elumelu said.

As part of Tony Elumelu's \$100 million commitment to empowering African entrepreneurs, 1,000 Tony Elumelu Entrepreneurs, representing 51 African countries from the Tony Elumelu Entrepreneurship Programme (TEEP) Class of 2015, converged near Lagos, Nigeria for an intensive two-day boot camp session, an unprecedented gathering of emerging African entrepreneurs, from 10-12 July, 2015.
